Sickness & Diarrhoea

We would like to remind parents and carers that all children who display the symptoms of this type of bug must not attend school for a minimum of 48 hours after the symptoms have occurred. By enforcing this 48 hour absence from school we will reduce, quite dramatically the number of pupils and staff that are being affected. We understand that absence of this length can cause problems for individual families but we are sure that all parents and carers want to work with us to ensure that our school is a healthy environment for our pupils and staff.

Drake Broughton Village Hall Refurbishments

The Parish Council have asked us to remind parents to be vigilant whilst using the car park. Please park with care and ensure children stay away from the fenced area. There have been reports of children collecting balls from behind the fenced area.

Further section 278 roadworks B4084 Drakes Broughton

There will be further road works to complete the section 278 developer works on the B4084 near Stonebow Road, Drakes Broughton. This is because the work scheduled during the end of last term and summer holidays was not completed due to workforce and material shortages (resurfacing and white lining). Work will continue between 15th to 20th November 2021. The advance notice should assist you in planning your travel time to school.

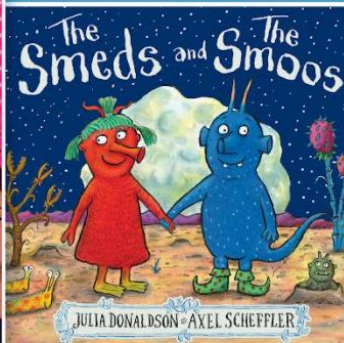
